Because of the late arrival of *Ugadhi* this year (due to the *Adhika Bhadrapada masa*), we are combining the *Ugadhi* event with the annual function. We are looking forward to celebrating the arrival of *Vijaya Nama Samvatsara* together with NASA family and friends during this year's Retreat.

We have found an excellent venue – Vanderkamp Center – near Syracuse, NY which will serve as an ideal retreat location for us. Registrants will be provided accommodations at Vanderkamp Center on a first come, first serve basis, so please be sure to send your registrations in early.

Please also note that beginning with this issue and going forward we will not be mailing the Chiguru/Newsletter via US Post. The efforts and costs for mailing are proving to be too high for a voluntary organization like ours. Hence, we will distribute them only via email (Please be sure to keep your contact details up to date with our secretary so you will not miss receiving any of our notifications). Thus this is the only copy you will receive of this issue. So be sure to print out the registration forms, fill them in, and mail them along with your check. We are also exploring on-line payment and registration methods. We will hopefully have it available for use next year.

1. Announcing NASA 2013 Annual Meeting:

Celebrating the Sankethi Heritage across Generations

After an extensive search of numerous sites at which to hold our annual NASA meeting, we are pleased to announce that this year NASA will host its annual retreat from <u>Saturday</u>, <u>May 25 (noon) through Monday</u>, <u>May 27 (noon)</u> at the <u>Vandercamp Retreat Center (http://www.vk.org/)</u> located in *Cleveland*, <u>NY</u> (not to be confused with Cleveland, OH when making travel arrangements!) about 45 minutes from Syracuse, NY.

Vanderkamp Center is an 840 acre, wooded retreat center located north of Oneida Lake, less than an hour from Rome, Oswego, and Utica, NY. Vanderkamp Center will offer our retreat attendees good opportunities to reconnect, recharge, and revitalize our Sankethi spirit in a peaceful and tranquil setting with comfortable accommodations. We will have access to:

- a Community Center with a meeting area of appropriate size for our group,
- spacious dining facilities
- accommodations with bedding, linen, and towels with fireplace in each building
- a private 45-acre lake that has been pristinely preserved with each of the buildings facing the lake
- canoeing / kayaking / row-boating / swimming activities
- fields for arranging sports activities (i.e., soccer, volleyball, cricket, field activities, low rope activities)
- indoor activities such as table tennis (ping pong), and foosball
- ten miles of scenic trails for hiking and biking
- BBQ and campfire facilities

We have also secured commercial kitchen facilities at Vandercamp Center in which the caterers for our event will prepare our traditional tasty and nutritious meals throughout our retreat weekend. The dining facilities have also been coordinated to accommodate our group's needs. While it was quite a challenge to find a venue to accommodate *all* of our needs, we are confident that Vandercamp Center fits the bill in many regards. We are enthusiastic about holding our annual event in this new location and are certain that the venue and programs being planned will hold broad appeal to you and your family!
